## Positive Behaviour for Learning

Our focus for PBL this week is on 'Positive Word Choices'.

Unfortunately, there are some lazy and disrespectful words that are used in our society. We are promoting that our students choose to use positive, kind words instead. Swear words have no place at Repton Public School.

We are encouraging students to use the THINK before you speak principle. Is it True, Helpful, Inspiring, Necessary, and Kind?

We are also focusing on using a gentle tone in our voices and to remain calm while speaking.

Slow gentle hand movements are much nicer than fast, jerky movements, which are far more aggressive.

We expect students to try to understand - Listen to what other people have to say about their feelings (without interrupting them) and try to put yourself in the other person's shoes.

Parents, if you could please have a conversation with your child about what swear words are, it will help them understand which words should not be used at school.

#### CAMP CREATIVE


