2/3/4 are coming along swimmingly as they practice for the big show on Thursday.

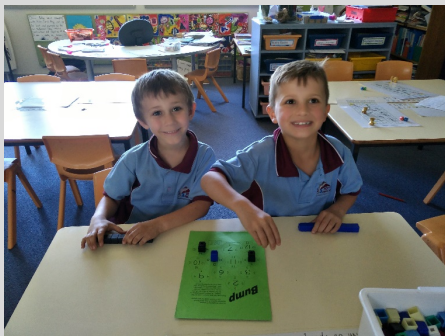

4/5/6 attended the Life Education Van this week, learning all about Healthy Relationships. The Year 6 group said a very sad final goodbye to Healthy Harold.





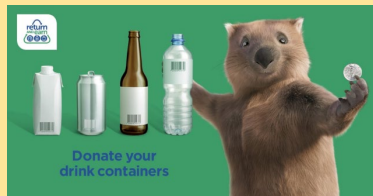
### PRODUCE TABLE EVERY TUESDAY

### Kalang River Changemakers



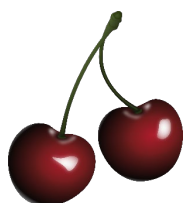

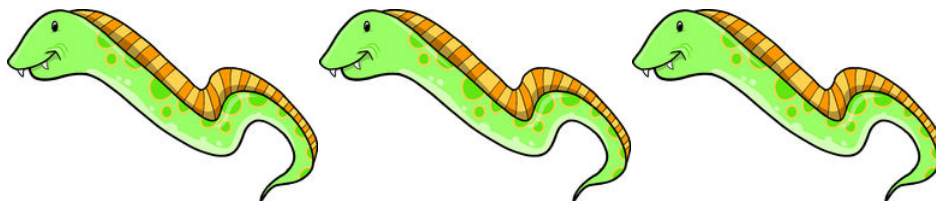
