## Music



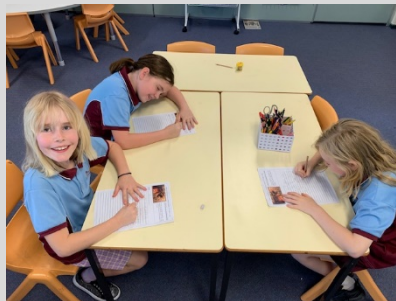
K/1 split into groups this week. They created a djembe drum rhythm and a xylophone melody, before coming back and playing the two sections together. Great work, K/1!

## K/1



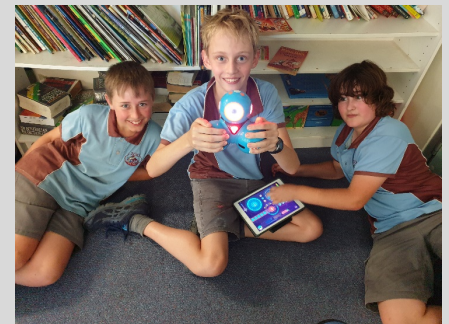
K/1 students do independent writing every day during literacy groups. They have made fantastic progress this year and I am very proud of them!

## PRODUCE TABLE EVERY TUESDAY

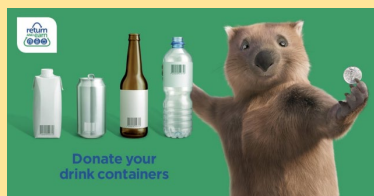
Students sell produce they have grown at school on a Produce table every Tuesday. We would like to add to this with surplus produce from outside the school that you may be willing to bring in.

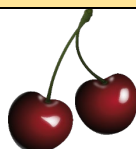
