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## Principal's Message

Welcome back: We would like to welcome back our existing students and welcome a few new families to our school for 2020. Our staff have enjoyed a refreshing break and are all very excited to be back in the classroom with their students.

Learning: Our staff participated in a day of learning and team building activities yesterday including Child protection, Emergency care procedures, anaphylaxis training and planning quality teaching for Mathematics. We then explored our local environment and made community links with cultural perspectives in the afternoon. A very successful first day back.

Mathematics: Our maths sessions are receiving a lot of focus this year as we have seen great results from our uninterrupted Literacy group sessions, we are working on stable maths sessions throughout the week for each of our classes. Additional support is being used with both extension and support groups. We have included text books in our planning for Years 1-6 which will support independent and guided learning activities.

Literacy: Our literacy sessions will begin in week 3 this term with our morning 2-hour sessions focused on L3 teaching for K-2 students and focus on comprehension for 3-6. Speech language programs will continue in the early years and individual goal setting is targeted in these sessions.

Kitchen Garden: Our Stephanie Alexander Kitchen Garden program is a major focus for our school and community. These lessons are going to run on a FRIDAY morning 9:30-11am this year. 

## Ethics classes at Repton Public School

Dear Parents and Carers,

### **Could you be an Ethics Teacher at Repton Public School in 2020?**

In ethics classes, children learn how to think logically, how to disagree respectfully and how to support their arguments with evidence.

Children discuss topics such as:

- Fairness
- Imagining how others feel
- How should we treat living things?
- What is laziness?
- How do we disagree in a respectful way?

We are always needing volunteers so that ethics classes can be made available for all families who have requested them. Ethics teachers facilitate discussions. A teaching background is not required. Full training is provided by Primary Ethics, the not-for-profit organisation approved to design curriculum and training for the ethics program. Training consists of a two-day workshop and short online modules. Lesson materials are provided.

**An ethics teacher training workshop will be held locally in Term One 2020 on 22<sup>nd</sup> and 23<sup>rd</sup> February.**

Suitable volunteers would have an interest in children's education and the development of thinking skills and need to be available on Fridays from 11:45 - 1:15 each week during school terms to teach a half hour class at Repton PS. A small amount of weekly preparation (printing and reading through lesson materials) is also required.
