All classes are ability based and have 2 hours Mon-Thursday of guided modelled and independent lessons to develop reading, writing and speaking and listening skills. Students and teachers work together to develop goals to make improvements in their learning. It is important that we focus on individual skill development as well as grade based achievement. Our expectations are very clear for each student to show and celebrate improvement and achievement.
