- Only online orders will be accepted after the day of photography (\*not for sibling photos) or paid over the phone on 02 66280511.

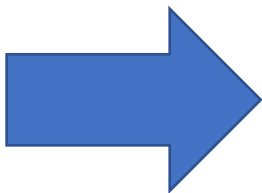

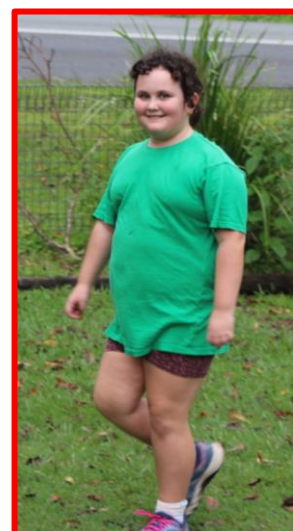
